

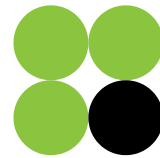

About Us



Milind Shikshan Sanstha Bramhapuri is a Maharashtra-based registered non-governmental organisation established on 18th October 1980 under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. Headquartered in Bramhapuri, Chandrapur District, the organisation has been consistently serving marginalised and vulnerable populations across rural Maharashtra and Goa for over four decades. Its core areas of intervention include elderly care, substance abuse rehabilitation, and accessible healthcare for economically disadvantaged communities. Operating strictly on a non-profit basis, the organisation is registered with the Charity Commissioner, Maharashtra, bearing Registration Number MH/313/80 and DARPAN ID MH/2016/0107067.

Our Mission

To provide shelter, rehabilitation, and accessible healthcare to marginalised populations – including abandoned elderly persons, individuals affected by substance abuse, and economically disadvantaged communities – ensuring equitable access to basic human dignity and care.

Our Vision

A society wherein every elderly citizen lives with dignity, every youth is free from addiction, and every family – irrespective of economic status – has access to essential healthcare and social support.

Our Objectives

- 1:** To provide free residential shelter, nutritional support, and medical care to abandoned and destitute elderly persons.
- 2:** To rehabilitate individuals suffering from substance dependency through structured de-addiction treatment and counselling.
- 3:** To deliver accessible and free healthcare services – including Allopathic, Ayurvedic, and Homeopathic – to underserved rural and tribal communities.
- 4:** To conduct awareness and sensitisation programs among youth on elderly care, family values, and social responsibility.
- 5:** To operate on a strictly non-profit basis, ensuring all resources are directed entirely toward beneficiary welfare.

Old Age Home – Mitali Old Age Home

Location: Juni Wadsa, Desaiganj, Maharashtra

Nature of Service: Residential care facility for abandoned and destitute elderly persons

Services Provided: Residential shelter, nutritious meals, clothing, medical care, and psychological support

Additional Facility: Day Care Centre, Chandrapur



De-Addiction Treatment and Guidance Centre

Nature of Service: Free residential de-addiction and rehabilitation programme

Substances Addressed: Alcohol, tobacco, gutka, and smoking-related dependency

Services Provided: Residential treatment, medical support, individual counselling, and post-rehabilitation follow-up

Beneficiaries (2022–2023): 362 individuals admitted and treated

Ayurvedic Guidance Camps

Coverage Area: Chandrapur District

Nature of Service: Community camps providing Ayurvedic consultation and health guidance to rural and tribal populations

Target Beneficiaries: Farmers, villagers, and tribal communities with limited access to formal healthcare



Homeopathic Guidance Camps

Nature of Service: Free Homeopathic consultation and treatment camps

Key Practitioners: Mr. M. M. Dongare, Ku. Vaishali Meshram

Beneficiaries Served: 63–79 patients per camp cycle, Chandrapur

Ten Bedded Hospital

Location: Alibag, Raigad District, Maharashtra

Nature of Service: Free inpatient and outpatient medical care

Target Beneficiaries: Scheduled Caste communities and economically disadvantaged individuals

Services Provided: General medical treatment, hospitalisation, and consultations at no cost to patients



Community Sensitisation Programmes

Coverage Area: Schools and colleges, Chandrapur District

Nature of Service: Awareness and sensitisation sessions on elderly care, family responsibility, and social values

Target Audience: Students at secondary and higher secondary levels



Operational Areas



The organisation operates primarily in the following regions:

- **Chandrapur District, Maharashtra** – De-addiction centre, old age home, day care centre, Ayurvedic and Homeopathic camps, sensitisation programmes
- **Gadchiroli District, Maharashtra** – Outreach and health camps
- **Raigad District, Maharashtra (Alibag)** – Ten Bedded Hospital
- **Rural and tribal areas of Goa** – Welfare activities for the underprivileged and elderly
